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### Seeking Feedback on EMR Interfaces

This EMR Circular is seeking feedback from **Suppliers, CfD Generators** and **Capacity Providers** on the straw man data groups and data items we presented at the EMR Interfaces workshop on 8 July 2014.

We discussed what data should be included in reports sent to **Suppliers, CfD Generators** and **Capacity Providers** over the Data Transfer Service (DTS) and/or alternative mechanism as outlined in [EMR Circular 7](#).

### What was the focus of the EMR Interfaces Workshop?

The EMR Interfaces workshop focused on two areas:

- To prioritise the automation of the various data flows and notices
  - to receive as DTS flows (or an alternative machine-readable format) so it can be loaded into a system
  - to receive in human-readable (password-protected PDF) format
- A 'straw man' definition of the data items to be included in a new DTS flows for **Suppliers, CfD Generators** and **Capacity Providers**

### What feedback are we seeking?

We are seeking feedback from **Suppliers, CfD Generators** and **Capacity Providers** on the following:

- Confirm and validate priorities and preferences for which data flows need to be accompanied by machine-readable data files (through DTS or alternative mechanism), in addition to the human-readable versions

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- Provide detailed feedback on the straw man data groups and data items we presented, with a view to getting the DTC Change Proposals to the MRA Development Board (MDB) on 31 July 2014

## What are the timescales involved for raising these DTC Change Proposals?
