New working practices are now published

This circular informs **CFD Generators** and **Capacity Providers** that new working practices (WP), are now published on the [EMRS website](#). These documents relate to Metering activities for Contracts for Difference (CFD) and Capacity Market (CM).

CFD Generators will be interested in the following:

- WP002 - CFD Private Network Meter Commissioning, Proving and Calibration Tests
- WP024 - CFD Settlement Required Information
- WP032 - CFD Further Conditions Precedent (Metering)
- WP033 - CFD Electrical Schematic Obligation
- WP134 - CFD Metering Technical Assurance

Both **Capacity Providers** and **CFD Generators** will be interested in the following:

- WP003 - EMR Trading Disputes and Non-compliances
- WP133 - EMR Metering Disputes Resolution Procedure

Questions covered in Working Practice 2 - CFD Private Network Meter Commissioning, Proving and Calibration Tests:

- What are the requirements for a CFD Generator operating on a Private Network?
- What are the different stages and the timescales involved?

This working practice provides the various templates of the forms and results' analysis that would be required to be completed or issued following the applicable test.

Questions covered in Working Practice 24 - CFD Settlement Required Information:

- What is the high level process that a CFD Generator must follow to ensure EMRS can confirm that the Settlement Required Information is achieved?
- How do CFD Generators request written confirmation from EMRS regarding its Settlement Required Information?
- What information does the CFD Generator need to provide EMRS for this process?

This working practice provides the required templates that will be used by EMRS and the CFD Generator within this process.

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Questions covered in Working Practice 32 - CFD Further Conditions Precedent (Metering):

- What further conditions precedent does this working practice cover?
- What evidence can the CFD Generator submit to demonstrate compliance against the Metering System?

Questions covered in Working Practice 33 - CFD Electrical Schematic Obligation:

- Why does the CFD Generator need to submit another Electrical Schematic Diagram?
- What is a material change to the Electrical Schematic Diagram?
- When and who do you inform if a material change occurs impacting the Electrical Schematic Diagram?

This working practice provides an example of an Electrical Schematic Diagram.

Questions covered in Working Practice 134 - CFD Metering Technical Assurance:

- Why are Metering Systems used by CFD Generators subject to the CFD Metering Technical Assurance process?
- How are the Metering Systems selected for the CFD Metering Technical Assurance process?
- How do CFD Generators get notified when a Technical Assurance Test is to be performed?

Questions covered in Working Practice 3 - EMR Trading Disputes and Non-compliances:

- When is this working practice used?
- What are the steps involved to inform the Low Carbon Contracts Company (LCCC) or the Electricity Settlement Company (ESC) of a Trading Dispute or non-compliances?

The process will be followed when the Balancing and Settlement Code Company (BSCCo) identifies a Trading Dispute or non-compliance (a Category 1 non-compliance confirmed via the Technical Assurance Agent (TAA)) for a site involved in the CM or CFD.

Questions covered in Working Practice 133 - EMR Metering Disputes Resolution Procedure:

- When does the Capacity Provider or CFD Generator use this process?
- What are the different stages and the timescales involved?
- Who manages this process for CFD Generators and Capacity Providers?
