Purpose For information

Erroneous BSC Metered Data Impacting Supplier's Operational Cost Levy Invoices

This circular informs **Suppliers** that the Operational Cost Levy invoices are impacted by an error in the metered data used in the calculations. The error is believed to be caused by a single Supplier submitting erroneous data into BSC Settlement. BSCCo identified this issue yesterday. This was communicated via [ELEXON Circulars](#):

- EL02324 - Issue with Settlement Data, Advice Notes and Credit Cover Percentage
- EL02322 - Issue with Settlement Data and Advice Notes

The error is currently impacting CFD Settlement for **Settlement Days 20 and 21 October 2015 at the SF Run**.

What is the impact on EMR Settlement?

The issue impacts the **Operational Cost Levy** calculations. The majority of Suppliers will have metered volumes higher than they should be for the Settlement Days impacted.

The following Settlement Days and invoice issue days will be impacted:

Settlement Date	Invoice Date	Settlement Code	Payment Date
20/10/2015	13/11/2015	SF	20/11/2015
21/10/2015	16/11/2015	SF	23/11/2015

Do I need to pay these invoices?

Yes, you do need to pay these invoices as per the [Contracts for Difference \(Electricity Supplier Obligations\) Regulations 2014](#) Regulation 23(4).

Has the issue been resolved?

No resolution has been obtained at present regarding this issue and potentially could impact further Settlement Days.

What rectification could happen to resolve these invoices?

We are working with Low Carbon Contracts Company (LCCC) to understand if this issue could be rectified for the impacted Settlement Days, 20 and 21 October 2015.

How will we be kept informed?

We'll continue to keep Suppliers informed of any further developments and of any resolution on this issue via EMR Circulars to Supplier Company Email(s) and the EMR Circular List.
