Purpose For action

Reminder: Capacity Providers must complete metering activities before the start of the 2017/18 Delivery Year

Capacity Providers who have a Capacity Agreement from the Early Auction (EA) 2017/18 and Transitional Auction (TA) 2017/18 must complete metering activities before the start of the 2017/18 Delivery Year.

[EMR Delivery Body](#), [Electricity Settlements Company](#) (ESC) and EMR Settlement Limited (EMRS), would like to highlight the tasks and deadlines for these metering activities:

- Metering Assessment
- Metering Test and Metering Statement
- DSR Test

Metering Assessment

Capacity Providers who have not completed deferred Metering Assessments or wish to make amendments to the existing Metering Assessments need to do complete this **as soon as possible**.

Within five working days of receiving the completed Metering Assessments, the Delivery Body will determine whether a Metering Test is required for the Capacity Market Unit (CMU). This information is passed on to the Capacity Providers and the relevant Capacity Market Register is updated.

The Delivery Body has produced a [Metering Assessment Guidance](#) to help Capacity Providers complete their Metering Assessment.

Metering Test

If, after completing the Delivery Body Metering Assessment process, a Metering Test is required for a Component within a CMU, a Capacity Provider needs to [contact EMRS](#) to request one.

A Metering Statement, as per [Schedule 6 of the Capacity Market \(Amendment\) Rules 2015](#), needs to be submitted for each Component that triggered a Metering Test. This must provide details of all Components making up the CMU.

All Metering Test and Metering Statement requests as well as any required metering information needs to be submitted to [EMRS Service Desk](#) by **1 June 2017**. This will enable EMRS to complete Metering Tests and issue metering test certificates in a timely manner. Any requests received after this date cannot be guaranteed to be completed in time.

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DSR Test

Unproven DSR CMUs must also carry out a DSR Tests with Delivery Body in accordance with [Capacity Market Rule 13.2](#) by **31 August 2017**. Non-completion of Metering Assessments and Metering Tests in time may impact the completion of the DSR Tests.

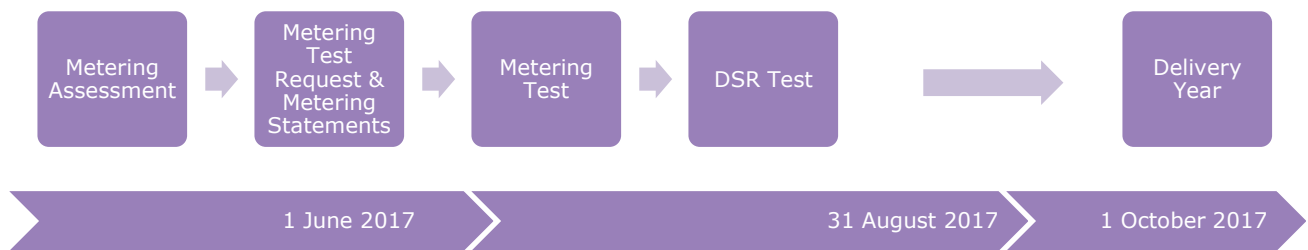
Please note:

- Where the **self-submission** by the Capacity Provider or their appointed Data Collector (DC) method is used, this will be **checked as part of the metering test**.
- Where a Capacity Provider requires a **DSR test**, they will need to **submit Metered Volumes to EMRS** as this will allow the Delivery Body to calculate their base line data as part of their DSR Test. This requires six weeks worth of metered volumes. In addition, due to settlement and validating processes, you will need to factor in a further three weeks as minimum.

What is the timeline for these activities?

The timeline below represents these activities in order of completion. It also illustrates the associated deadlines for these metering activities required before the start of Delivery Year on **1 October 2017**.
