## Reminder: Deadline for applications for Green Excluded Electricity

**Suppliers** have until the **30 June 2017** to apply for a determination that an amount of electricity supplied is Green Excluded Electricity (GEE) for the quarterly obligation period **1 October 2016 to 31 December 2016**. Suppliers submit applications to EMRS who calculate the exemption on behalf of [Low Carbon Contracts Company](#).

Where the amount of electricity is determined as GEE in accordance with the Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations) Regulations 2014<sup>1</sup>, this will be taken into account in the quarterly reconciliation calculation as a retrospective amendment. The amount will be exempted from the Suppliers daily and quarterly contribution.

### Who does this impact?

**Suppliers** seeking a determination that an amount of electricity supplied is GEE in accordance with the Contracts for Difference (Electricity Supplier Obligations) Regulations 2014<sup>2</sup>.

### What evidence do I need to submit?

The evidence must be in accordance with Regulation 3(2)<sup>3</sup>. Ofgem has developed a [spreadsheet](#) that enables Suppliers to input the relevant data to evidence the supply of GEE. The spreadsheet can be used as the application.

To support Suppliers on the evidence required, LCCC have published a [guidance document](#).

### Who do I submit my application to?

Suppliers submit applications to EMRS via [email](#). Applications for the quarterly obligation period **1 October 2016 to 31 December 2016** must be submitted by **30 June 2017**.

### What is the cap for the quarterly obligation period?

The cap for GEE supplied during a quarterly obligation period is illustrated in the table below.

Financial Year	Cap for the quarterly obligation period
<b>2016/17</b>	2,029,313.0 MWh
<b>2017/18</b>	2,232,244.3 MWh

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## What are the subsequent application windows for 2017?

This table below illustrates the following:

- application window for the 2017 quarterly obligation periods
- where submissions provided by the start of the sixth month will be taken into account during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarterly reconciliation
- any remaining submissions will be addressed during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarterly reconciliation

<b>1 Jul 17 – 30 Sep 17</b>	1 Jan 18 - 31 Mar 18	Apr 18	Jul 18
<b>1 Oct 17 – 31 Dec 17</b>	1 Apr 18 – 30 Jun 18	Jul 18	Oct 18
