

EMR CAPACITY MARKET METERING WEBINAR - QUESTIONS AND ANSWER

No	Question	Answer
1.	<p>If I have provided Metering Assessment for a Proven DSR in a previous auction and nothing has changed, do I still have to re-submit the Metering Assessment?</p> <p>Not sure I cloned CMUs this year. I shall re-submit Metering Statements regardless, just in case.</p>	<p>It would depend on whether the questions have been answered in the application. If the answers for the specific CMU Application are blank or deferred then you would need to complete the assessment. If you have cloned the CMU, the answers should have followed with it.</p> <p>If the answers have been completed in the application and nothing has changed, you don't need to resubmit.</p>
2.	<p>If you have selected CMRS Metering at Pre-qualification, can you amend this to non-CMRS without penalty?</p>	<p>Yes, you can change the CMRS status. You need to email the Delivery Body at emr@nationalgrid.com telling us which CMU you wish to change and the Delivery Body can make the necessary changes.</p>
3.	<p>Can you complete a T-1 metering assessment for an unproven DSR before the auction?</p> <p>Do all unproven DSR components have to complete a Metering Test? Or is it dependant on the Metering of the component?</p>	<p>As long as all of the components in the DSR CMU are confirmed and in the portal (as per rule 8.3.3A(b)) then a Metering Assessment can take place.</p> <p>It is dependent on the Metering set up of each component and the answers provided to the questions asked in the assessment process.</p>
4.	<p>How much earlier CP gets notice for a site audit?</p>	<p>Following a Metering Test Certificate deadline the Settlement Body will determine the percentage of sites in the risk category to have a Site Audit. These will be randomly selected by EMRS and the Capacity Provider will be notified, typically within one month of the Metering Test Certificate deadline. Any date for a Site Audit will then be agreed between the Capacity Provider and the Metering Agent. The only requirement is that the Site Audit is completed within the relevant Delivery Year.</p>
5.	<p>If my company participates both in STOR and Capacity Market and I receive a call from both schemes at the</p>	<p>The Baseline Methodology calculation (Schedule 2 of the Rules) accounts for any balancing services action (Schedule 2 3.1) taken following an instruction from the</p>
