Guidance in the event of the Capacity Market Restart now published on the EMRS website

On behalf of the [Electricity Settlements Company](#) (ESC), EMRS would like to inform **Suppliers** and **Capacity Providers** that we have published a new guidance document '**G22 - Capacity Market Settlement Restart**' on the [EMRS website](#). This guidance has been created to reflect the updates to the Capacity Market Rules and Regulations to allow for the restart of the Capacity Market.

Who should read this guidance?

Suppliers and Capacity Providers.

What's included in this guidance?

- Updates to EMRS's processes to reflect the rules and regulations relating to CM restart.
- The process that Suppliers and Capacity Providers are to follow in the event there is a positive State aid decision.
- An overview of the payments Suppliers may be required to make in respect to the CM Standstill.
- An explanation of the different CM Standstill Capacity Provider Payments.

When will related Working Practices or Guidance be published?

We will be publishing further working practice and guidance documents to support Suppliers and Capacity Providers once the CM standstill ends. Once further documents are published we will communicate this via an [EMR Circular](#).

Guidance Documents	
G11 – Termination of Capacity Agreements	Guidance on the pre-qualification process to confirm that Capacity Providers are suitable recipients of Capacity Agreements in order to partake in the Capacity Market.
G14 – Supplier CM Credit Cover	Guidance on how the Capacity Market scheme mitigates risk of a funding shortfall through the provision of Credit Cover and how this Credit Cover is managed by EMRS on behalf of the Electricity Settlements Company (ESC).
G15 – CM Supplier Payments	Guidance to provide Suppliers with information on what the Capacity Market payments are for, how they are calculated and when to expect the associated invoices or credit notes.
