Purpose For information

Changes to the Capacity Market Volume Reallocation Notification process

EMRS, on behalf the [Electricity Settlements Company](#) (ESC), would like to inform **Capacity Providers** that the Capacity Market Volume Reallocation Notifications (CMVRNs) process is being updated. EMRS will implement subscription preferences for the Capacity Provider to submit CMVRNs via email or Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP). Once a CMVRN submission is received, automated notifications will be sent to the Capacity Provider via the preferred method.

This change is being implemented following feedback received from Delivery Partners during the lessons learnt workshop, held after the May 2018 Mock Stress Event.

What action do I need to take to receive these notifications?

Please let us know by **25 November 2019** via email at contact@emrsettlement.co.uk the following;

1. Your preferred method is either via **email or SFTP**
2. Confirm the contact that has been designated to receive the CMVRN notifications, and if applicable, who to provide SFTP details. The contact must be **one** of the following – Primary Party Authority, Finance Authority, Operating Authority or Trading Contact. Please provide the following information below:
 - First and Last name
 - Email address
 - Mobile telephone number
 - EMR Party ID

What happens if no preferences are chosen?

In the event that a Capacity Provider has not provided a preferred method, the SFTP route will be the default to access their CMVRN notifications.

The Capacity Provider authorised contact is required to get in touch with EMRS, via email at contact@emrsettlement.co.uk in order to receive their SFTP login details.

When will this change come into effect?

These changes will come into effect on 26 November 2019 and [WP48 – Volume Reallocation](#) will be updated and published on the EMRS website to reflect the changes summarised above.
