Purpose For information

Capacity Providers to be paid in full in January for the CM Standstill period

EMRS, on behalf of [The Electricity Settlements Company](#) (ESC), would like to inform all Suppliers that following the Electricity Supplier and Capacity Market Bulletin of 13 December 2019 confirming mutualisation of the standstill shortfall, ESC has announced that there will be no scaling down of standstill capacity payments.

Capacity providers are to be paid in full in January 2020 for the CM standstill period. In accordance with [The Electricity Capacity \(No. 1\) Regulations 2019](#), ESC will be issuing credit notes to capacity providers in respect of their standstill capacity payments on 13 January 2020, with transfer of funds on 20 January 2020.

Supplementary mutualisation

ESC has confirmed that there are sufficient funds to pay all capacity providers their standstill capacity payments in full, and therefore the supplementary mutualisation that is provided for in the regulations will not be required. There will be no further invoices to those suppliers in respect of the standstill period.

EMRS and ESC would like to thank all suppliers that have paid promptly, enabling successful collection of the standstill capacity payments.

Suppliers on the Non-Payment Register

ESC is continuing to work with those suppliers who have not fully paid their outstanding liability. Any recovered amounts will be returned to suppliers who have paid a standstill mutualisation invoice, in accordance with the regulations.
