Purpose For Information

BEIS issues consultation on proposed changes to Supplier Obligation Regulations

EMRS, on behalf of [Low Carbon Contracts Company](#) (LCCC) would like to inform **Suppliers** that Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) published a consultation on the [proposed changes to the Electricity Supplier Obligation Regulations in response to COVID-19](#).

This consultation covers the proposed changes to the Regulations to reflect how the one-off, interest-free loan [to be provided by BEIS to LCCC](#) would work in practice in reducing the Supplier Obligations in the short term, and the recovery mechanics of this loan. The consultation includes how the amount of the loan will be determined, and how this amount will be translated into reductions in current supplier obligations and increases in a future quarter.
